Gammer Goose's Merry Tales and Songs

Music and Fables for All Ages Presented By Anne and Rob Burns as A Reasonable Facsimile



A fun program of old music and instruments, "Gammer Goose's Merry Tales and Songs" is sprinkled with stories to capture the imagination of the young and the young at heart. Everyone is familiar with the tales of Mother Goose, first published in the late 17th and early 18th centuries, but Anne & Rob Burns, as A Reasonable Facsimile, go back even further with stories and music from the Renaissance. We fancy that our tales would

have been told by an ancestor of Mother Goose: Gammer (grandmother) Goose. Come *down* and have a *gander* with your whole *gaggle*!

Anne and Rob incorporate humor and audience participation to introduce young audiences to earlier music. Anne and Rob play lively, rhythmic music which invites audience participation. The performers bring history alive with instruments from the Renaissance: shawm, drum, crumhorn, bagpipe, recorder, gittern and more.

Solo format for above: Anne Burns shares stories and tunes on shawm, recorder, crumhorn, gittern, percussion and other Renaissance instruments. This version is more available on weekdays, and is lower priced than the duo program.
