A Concert of Fun Old Music and Instruments For Children and Families

All ages will be tickled and fascinated by the unique instruments and songs played and sung by town musicians ("waits"), "Nan and Robin Piper" (**Anne and Rob Burns, A Reasonable Facsimile**) in "Renaissance Music Rocks!" These costumed performers bring history alive with instruments from the Renaissance: shawms, drums, crumhorns, bagpipes, recorders, lutes and more.

Anne and Rob incorporate humor and audience participation to introduce young audiences to earlier music. The children are even asked to help supply lyrics for additional verses of a four hundred-year-old song. Anne and Rob play lively, danceable music that the audience can sing and clap along with. Some may want to get up and dance!



ONE-PERSON BAND format for this program: "Nan Piper" serves up Renaissance music on flute, crumhorn, shawm, fife, drum, recorder, lute and Renaissance guitar, sometimes playing two things at once! This version is more available on weekdays, and is lower priced than the duo program.
